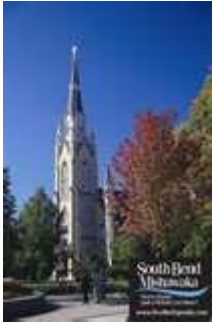

A nice summer day to South Bend for a guided walking tour of the **Notre Dame Campus** with visits to the **Basilica of the Sacred Heart** - this campus landmark was designated by the Vatican as a Basilica in 1992. The Basilica was built in the shape of a cross and contains seven chapels, the **Grotto**, Main Building (the **Golden Dome**) - constructed in 1879 with its famed Golden Dome towers above a campus of 1,250 acres, with thousands of trees and shrubs with two spring-fed lakes. The 16-foot statue of Notre Dame (Our Lady) tops the dome, which is gilded in 23-carat gold. and the Hesburgh Library ("**Touchdown Jesus**"). Book store as well. We will have a plated lunch at the **Tippecanoe Place Restaurant** – once the home of the Studebaker Family who built the mansion over a century ago. This afternoon you'll have a chance to visit **Copshaholm, The Oliver Mansion**, a 38-room home of turn-of-the-century industrialist Joseph Doty Oliver and his family built over 100 years ago. It has three floors with 14 fireplaces and 9 bathrooms. Then we'll tour the **Studebaker National Museum**. The Collection also includes seven objects designated as "National Treasures" including the carriage Abraham Lincoln rode to Ford's Theatre the night of his assassination, the Family Conestoga Wagon, and a new exhibit The American station wagon. Also, Military vehicles that Studebaker made as far back as 1857. On our way home a Stop at **Crystal Springs Creamery** for a tasty treat. Come join us for a day of great treasures right here in our Indiana Home.
