



NEW YORK FINGER LAKES

Our first day will be traveling to the **Finger Lakes** region of **New York state**. The Finger Lakes are a group of eleven long, narrow, roughly north-south lakes located directly south of Lake Ontario. We arrive in Penn Yan NY for our 4-night Hampton Inn lodging on the north end of Keuka Lake. This evening an enjoyable dinner at the hotel. **Day 2:** Visit to Seneca Falls NY (near Cayuga Lake) and the



Womens Rights Museum. It tells the story of the first Women's Rights Convention held in 1848. Explore the revolutionary words of the Declaration of Sentiments. Lunch (oyo) in downtown with a stop at the **"It's a Wonderful Life"** Museum. Frank Capra visited Seneca Falls while working on the script and the town has long believed itself to be the inspiration for key scenes in the film and Bedford Falls itself. Our afternoon



is spent in the Skaneateles Lake Area. Visit a **Strawberry Fields Hydroponic Farm**. "Hydroponics" grows plants in a "medium" by supplying all the necessary nutrients in the plant's "water" rather than in the soil. Learn how they grow 17,000 u- pick strawberry/vegetable plants on just a quarter of an acre. Free time to explore the **Village of Skaneateles** before our lovely dinner at the **Sherwood Inn**. Established in 1807 as a Tavern, but was also a hotel, hospital and finally a fine dining and comfortable lodging today.



Day 3: Today exploring around Keuka Lake. Visit the **Glenn Curtiss Museum**, a transportation museum. Curtiss invented the motorcycle, RV and took flight way beyond the Wright Brothers. A quick visit to **Bully Hill Vineyards** for tasting on your own and the amazing views of the lake. Travel north the east side of Keuka Lake for a special Lunch at the **Belhurst Castle** nestled on Seneca Lake. We'll Drive by **waterfalls in Montour Falls** on the Southern end of Seneca Lake. Finally enjoy a **Scenic Cruise** aboard the Seneca Spirit. Discover the beauty and charm of Seneca Lake as it can only be seen from the water. Dinner is (oyo) at the hotel. **Day 4:** Canandaigua Lake is our destination today. Visit the **Sonnenburg Mansion and Gardens**, a 50-acre estate and a New York State Historic Park offering one of the few remaining estates with a Queen Anne Victorian-style mansion and formal gardens in America. We'll have lunch on your own in Canandaigua before our **Paddlewheel cruise** on Canandaigua Lake. Our Dinner this evening is at **The New York Kitchen**.
