Built in 1821, The original mansion was a two-story, Federal-style building built with bricks manufactured onsite by skilled people. After a fire in 1834, Jackson had the current 13-room, Greek Revival structure built on the same foundation as the former house. Also enjoy a complimentary wine tasting at the on-site Natchez Hills Winery. Free time in downtown Nashville for lunch on your own. A visit to the **Country Music Hall of Fame**



and Museum. The Museum's extensive Objects Collection includes nearly 500 musical instruments, more than 1,900 items of stage wear, personal clothing, and accessories, and thousands of other three-dimensional objects—from microphones to automobiles—documenting the history and culture of country music. We return to the Hotel to freshen up. Tonight, we have reserved seats for the **CabaRay Dinner Show**, Staring **Ray Stevens**. Be thoroughly entertained with a full concert, jam-packed with Ray's iconic hits and comedy classics. Ray will take you down memory lane with tales and stories from his legendary career one last time. Ray is retiring at the end of this year. **Day 3:** This morning a leisurely **Delta boat ride** through the hotel's conservatory and exploring the hotel. Free time for a little shopping and lunch at **Opry Mills**



Mall. This afternoon, we will enjoy **ICE**, a holiday tradition. Experience the interactive exciting themed icy wonderland. Take a slippery ride down our gigantic ice slides and marvel at our glistening Nativity scene. Bundle up 1.5 million pounds of ice can get cold. Tonight, we have dinner at the **Santa Fe Cattle Company** and enjoy reserved seats at the world famous, **Grand Ole Opry**. The longest-running radio broadcast in US history.
