Through the years, it has been the summer home for Nashville socialite Adelia Acklen and her family, temporary headquarters of the Union army, and a women's college and seminary. One of the most elaborate antebellum homes in the South. It was then purchased by two women who in 1890 started a college which evolved into Belmont University. Free time for a little shopping



and lunch at **Opry Mills Mall**. Spend the afternoon enjoying the **Opryland Hotel**. Take a leisurely **Delta boat ride** through the hotel's conservatory and exploring the hotel.
