Day 1: Enjoy the Michigan scenery as we travel North during the color season to **Agawa Canyon** in Canada. We will cross the **Mighty Mac Bridge**, currently the fifth longest suspension bridge in the world, to the **Upper Peninsula** for our three-night stay in **Sault Ste. Marie, Michigan**. A neat Dinner at “**The Antlers**”. It’s the decor that you’ll remember. From ceiling-hung geese to wall-mounted foxes and decades of collected oddities, The Antlers is equal parts museum, hunting lodge, and fever dream. **Day 2:** Ride with the Freighters on the **Soo Locks Boats Ride** through the **Soo Locks** in Michigan’s oldest city, Sault Ste. Marie. We’ll visit the **Upper Tahquamenon Falls** for the beauty of nature. The chocolate-colored water and the beautiful fall leaves are one to be remembered. Lunch at **Camp 33**. Whitefish Point, MI is the home of the **Shipwreck Museum** where evidence of the unrelenting fury of Lake Superior. **Lake Superior** has earned the reputation of being the most treacherous of the Great Lakes. Artifacts and exhibits tell the stories of sailors and ships who braved the waters of Superior and those who were lost to its menacing waves. The Edmonds Fitzgerald being the most famous. A stop at the **Locks Visitor Center** to see the ships go through the Locks. Dinner will be at **Franks Place**, a local restaurant. **Day 3:** All aboard! Got your Passport? We’ll cross the International Bridge for The **Agawa Canyon Train**, a Rail Adventure into the Heart of the **Canadian Wilderness** and one of the **most popular train tours in North America**. This wilderness excursion will transport you 114 miles north of Sault Ste. Marie, Ontario, over towering trestles, alongside pristine northern lakes, and rivers and through the impressive granite rock formations and vast mixed forests of the Canadian Shield. Through the large windows, the beauty of the region will unfold, and you will experience the same rugged landscapes that inspired some of Canada’s most notable landscape art. As the train winds its way through this immense land, a GPS triggered commentary will tell you about upcoming points of interest and share some of the rich history of the region with stories of the Ojibway, fur traders, explorers and entrepreneurs that pioneered this vast wilderness and called it home. Locomotive mounted digital cameras will provide an ‘engineer’s eye view’ on the flat screen monitors installed throughout the coaches. You will travel 500 feet down to the floor of the **Agawa Canyon** where you will experience the pristine beauty up close. Enjoy a quiet boxed picnic lunch beside the Agawa River. After our return to the States. Enjoy dinner at the **Soo Ste Marie Country Club**. **Day 4:** We begin our journey home with a stop at the **Cross in the Woods**. What an amazing seven-ton site. A tremendous journey to see the color of the Agawa Canyon.
